

## **Using Network Attached Computer Equipment at the The Svedberg Laboratory (TSL) during the AUC 2009 Conference**

For security reasons, the following rules have to be followed before connecting computer equipment to the network at TSL:

Wired connection (for the workshop):

- Nothing may be connected to the wired network without informing Ib Kôersner, preferably well in advance by mail to [system@tsl.uu.se](mailto:system@tsl.uu.se).
- All wired machines have to be known by the name of computer, user and the MAC address.
- All these wired machines have to be patched with the latest patches available and have antivirus software updated with the latest virus definitions available.

Wireless connection:

- For the wireless network you need an account that will be given to you as part of the conference material. To get access to the network start a browser and try to reach any site. You will be prompted for your account details.
- For your own security you are advised to keep your computer updated with patches and virus definitions.

All connections:

- Use DHCP to obtain an IP address when connecting to any network at TSL.
